



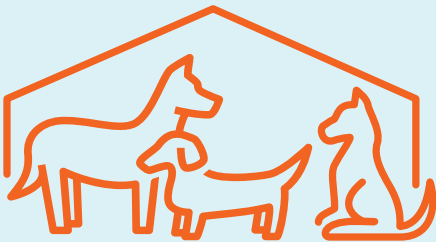

The American Veterinary Medical Association lists kennel cough as one of the top disease risks, particularly in dogs that have frequent contact with other dogs.<sup>2</sup> *Bordetella bronchiseptica* (*Bb*) typically gets the blame, when in fact many vaccine preventable infectious agents are capable of causing symptoms, including canine parainfluenza virus (CPiV) and canine adenovirus type 2 (CAV-2). Help prevent the preventable with VANGUARD Rapid Resp Intranasal and VANGUARD CIV vaccines.

## VANGUARD® RAPID RESP 3 – “THE BOARDING VACCINE”

For healthy dogs 8 weeks of age or older:

- Helps prevent canine respiratory diseases caused by *Bordetella bronchiseptica* (*Bb*), CAV-2 and CPiV pathogens associated with Canine Infectious Respiratory Disease (CIRD)
- The *Bb*, CAV-2 and CPiV fractions are the first to be approved with **1-year duration of immunity** for each antigen
- Multiple antigenic options available: trivalent (*Bb*, CAV-2, CPiV), bivalent (*Bb*, CPiV) and monovalent (*Bb*)
